

Purpose of the Parental Consent Form

The primary purpose of this form is to obtain formal permission and acknowledgment from a parent or legal guardian for a minor (under age 18) to enroll in courses at University of Maryland Global Campus (UMGC).

1. Parent/Guardian Acknowledgment & Consent (All must be checked/acknowledged)

Parent/guardian must confirm:

- Student cannot enroll until all steps are completed (application, admission, registration, and this form)
- Non-payment consequences (cancellation, holds, collections)
- Authorization for student to enroll in UMGC courses

Please review and complete this form carefully if the student is under 18 years of age.

Required Steps:

1. Complete all student information fields at the top of the form
2. Review each acknowledgment statement and check all required boxes
3. Select ONE option under the FERPA (education records access) section
4. Sign and date the consent statement
