

UMGC ADJUNCT FACULTY SCHOLARSHIP STATEMENT

Introduction

The University of Maryland Global Campus (“UMGC”) Adjunct Faculty Scholarship (the “Scholarship”) is available to all eligible adjunct faculty (as defined in Section I. below) The Scholarship is being offered to recognize the commitment and contribution to quality education by adjunct faculty at UMGC.

I. Applicant Eligibility

1. Applicants must have completed teaching a minimum of 30 credit hours for UMGC prior to the semester for which a Scholarship is requested.
2. Applicants must be active and in good standing as an adjunct faculty member (i.e., the UMGC-Asia or UMGC-Europe adjunct faculty contract is in effect or the UMGC-Adelphi adjunct has a contract or is in participation status).
3. Applicants must be admitted into a degree program at UMGC, enrolled in the requested course, and meet all requirements for the coursework toward which the Scholarship funds, as defined below, will be applied. (Degree-seeking status is a requirement for the administration of Scholarship Funds; for purposes of this Scholarship, it does not mean that you necessarily intend to complete a degree.) The Office of Financial Aid will review the application to verify that the applicant is eligible for the Scholarship.
4. If an applicant is or has been a UMGC student at the time of application, to be eligible for the Scholarship, the applicant must be a student in good academic standing and meet the standards for satisfactory academic progress for financial aid recipients.
5. The Scholarship will not be awarded if the applicant is eligible for UMGC tuition remission for the requested course.

II. Use of the Scholarship Funds

1. Scholarship funds are limited to two course enrollment per aid year (one course per semester). The aid year starts at the beginning of the summer semester.
2. Funds awarded under the Scholarship (“Scholarship Funds”) will be credited by UMGC toward tuition and for no other purpose, including by way of example, the UMGC technology fee.

3. The Scholarship does not apply to courses within the Graduate School executive programs, non-credit programs.
4. Scholarship Funds may be taxable as income under the United States or other income tax laws and regulations.

III. Application and Selection Process

1. The Scholarship application is available on [Adjunct Faculty Scholarship Form](#).
2. An applicant may submit the Scholarship application form from the date registration opens for the applicable semester until 2 weeks to the first day of class for the applicant's requested course.
3. The Office of Financial Aid will award the Scholarship until all of the allocated funding for adjunct faculty has been disbursed on a first come, first served basis.
4. Applicants must reapply for the Scholarship each academic year.
5. Please keep in mind that this scholarship funding is limited and is awarded to those as they apply and register for courses.
